Essex Fire Service COMMUNITY SAFETY

Did you know you can invite Thurrock fire-fighters into your home to ensure that you are as "fire safe" as possible? Crews from the local station are able to offer professional advice on home fire safety and if necessary fit free smoke alarms with 10 year batteries. The fire service is doing all that it can to ensure as many homes have correctly fitted and maintained smoke alarms. Safety Rules for Children

Teaching children the following basic rules of fire safety is a lifelong investment.

Never play with matches or lighters, if you see matches or lighters lying around, tell a grown up.

Don't play close to a fire, heater or leave toys near a fire or heater.

Don't pull on electric cables or fiddle with electrical appliances

Never switch on the cooker.

Don't put anything on top of the cooker or touch saucepans. Don't put things on top of heaters or lights.
